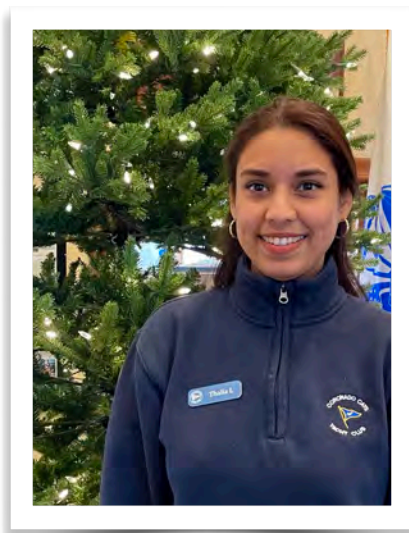

I want to thank most of the Marina Tenants for bringing their vessels up to the marina standards of our yacht club.

One of our concerns is that a few vessels have engine concerns, making them inoperable. As you know, if boats don't get used, they, in most cases, will have problems with the different functions of the boat.

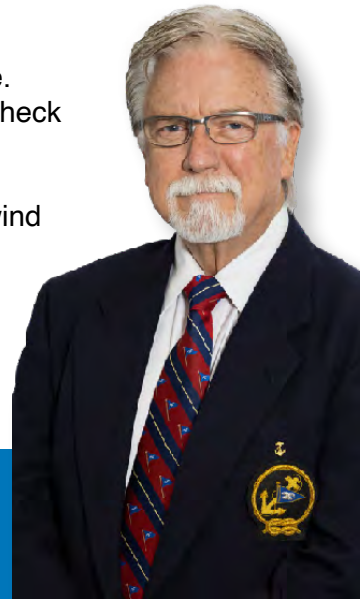
We want to give the boat owners who haven't been out of their slip in a year an opportunity to have their boat inspected at our guest dock. Each of these tenants will receive a 90-day notice, which should give them ample time to get their boat ready for inspection. Your boat will need to go, under its own power, to the bridge and back to our guest dock, where we will assist you in landing.

One of our goals is to maintain a clean and safe marina. Please stop putting unwanted items in and around the trash cans and dumpsters. Also, we are not equipped to get rid of your old batteries.

The rainy season will be here soon; please ensure all your hatches and ports seal up properly. Check your bilge pumps and float switches. Float switches aren't as reliable as they used to be. Your pump will not work without an operable float switch. It might also be an excellent time to check your power cords and look for burned areas around the male and female connections.

Last but not least, make sure you have the appropriate size dock lines for your vessels. High wind conditions can destroy an under-size dock line.

As we approach winter, please visit your boats as often as possible. We look forward to seeing you on the docks enjoying the Holiday Season.

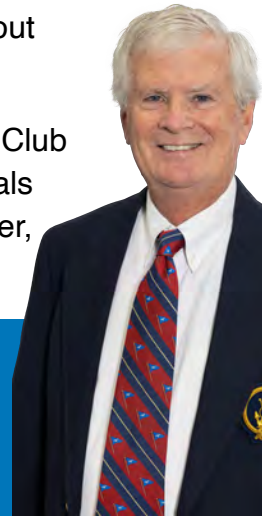

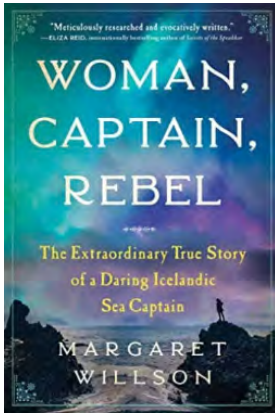

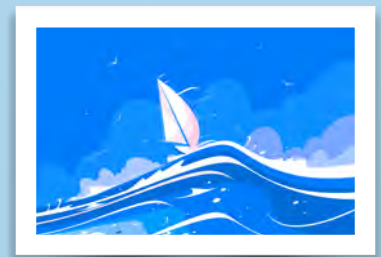
